## Cat-agonia: the pumas of Chile



ACCOMPANIED BY ONE OF THE BEST GUIDES IN THE ENTIRE REGION, THIS PHOTO-FOCUSED GROUP OF SIX WILL BE SPLIT ACROSS TWO VEHICLES, ENABLING YOU TO EXIT QUICKLY WHEN NEEDED TO GRAB SHOTS, AND ALSO TO BE ABLE TO ACCESS REMOTE AREAS OF THE LANDSCAPE. BY OPERATING ON PRIVATE LAND, WE CAN OFF-ROAD WHEN REQUIRED AND GET YOU AS CLOSE TO THE ACTION AS POSSIBLE, WHILST UTILISING TWO SPOTTERS TO TARGET US TOWARDS YOUR INTENDED BIG CAT. AS SOMEONE WHO WAS INVOLVED IN THE HABITUATION OF THESE CATS AROUND TEN YEARS AGO, I CAN ASSURE YOU THAT THIS IS THE ONLY WAY TO CHASE THOSE SHOTS YOU HAVE DREAMED OF....BUT IN A BIT MORE COMFORT THAN I HAD TO ENDURE BACK THEN!

#### YOUR ITINERARY....

## Day 1: Arrive in Punta Arenas (1 night)

Arrive in the southern city of Punta Arenas where you will be met by our local "Faunavista" representative and transferred to your hotel for the night (no meals).

## Day 2 Transfer to Puerto Natales (6 nights)

Early morning, check out from your hotel and a road transfer (two vehicles) to Puerto Natales, on the edge of Torres Del Paine National Park. Here is your base for exploring the private ranch lands on which the majority of pumas reside over the next 5 full days. You will stop on the way for lunch (and possibly the condor roost), and arrive in the afternoon, ready for the next day. You will be on full-board during your stay.

From Day 3 onwards, you will be up and out all day in search of these fantastic big cats, with cubs at this time of year a real possibility as mothers will have started to allow them more freedom and the chance to explore, rather than hide them away. The photography will all be on foot, and our guide will ensure you are in the best position at all times to maximise the opportunity. It's a life-changing experience. As well as pumas, other wildlife – guanaco, skunks, foxes, rheas etc – will also be on the hit-list.

### Day 8 Transfer to Punta Arenas (1 night)

Today, sadly, you will have to say goodbye to this beautiful part of the world and make your way south back to Puna Arenas. You may do the condor roost today on your way back (if not done on the way up), as afternoons are usually better because of air currents and wind conditions. This is a chance to be photographing at eye-level with these almost mythical birds. Reaching Punta Arenas in the late afternoon/early evening, you will then be dropped at your hotel (dinner own arrangements).


## Day 9 Transfer to Punta Arenas airport
